Your vote will not be counted unless the envelope is **postmarked before the day of the election, Friday 7**th **June**, and received by the returning officer not later than five days after the date of the election. Please post it as soon as possible as New Zealand Post has reduced the frequency of its mail delivery service.

If you are delivering your voting paper, please ensure that it is **delivered before noon on Friday 7**th **June** in the enclosed envelope. It should be placed in the B.O.T. votes box in the school office.

STRIKE ACTION ON WEDNESDAY 29 MAY - SCHOOL CLOSED

School will be closed tomorrow, Wednesday. There is no supervision for children at school. Our Before and After School Care service will not be running.

We greatly appreciate the community support that we have already received following the decision by teachers and principals to strike on Wednesday 29th May.

The decision to take further strike action was not taken lightly by any of us. For the first time, both primary and secondary teachers are striking together.

Teachers are striking for a significant pay jolt, improvements to workloads and more support for children with additional needs.
