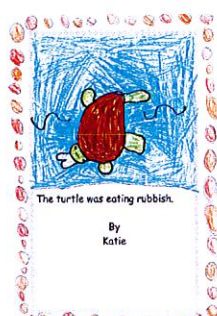

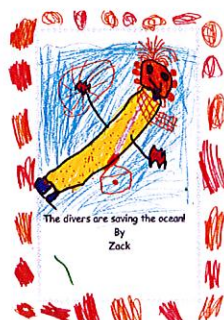
Late Notice

Measles in Auckland schools

Please vaccinate your child or young person if they have not had one measles (MMR) vaccine. It is free at your GP.

Students in a class with someone who has measles may be asked to stay home for one to two weeks, if they have had no MMR vaccinations.

Students with one or more MMR vaccinations can still attend school.

Measles info at: arphs.health.nz/measles

Check your child's immunisation records in their Well Child/Tamariki Ora book or ring your GP clinic.

Tell your GP or after hours clinic if you suspect measles before you arrive, so you don't infect others.

Symptoms: cough, runny nose, fever, sore red eyes, then a rash.

Moving forward together - te aho whakaitia tahi

The Kaipātiki Kāhui Ako are pleased to announce a FREE evening with Kathryn Berkett.

In January Kathryn spoke at our annual teachers' conference around building resilience in our students. Kathryn was inspirational, so much so, that the principal wanted to ensure that our community have an opportunity to hear Kathryn's messages. There are two different sessions depending on the age of your children. Come to one or both!

The Early Years 5-9 years

We all want our children and young ones to be able to make good decisions, to over-ride impulses and to be able to function in a socially acceptable way. These, in our own ways, are how we become good contributing citizens to our community. So how do we build the ability to do this? How do we help our children learn to operate in a way that will avoid them throughout their lives, whatever bumps and waves come at them?

This neuroscience session, delivered in easy-to-understand language, will help you see how you can play a crucial role in developing this in your children. The information will show you how you can build resilience, encourage emotional intelligence and build visually support them to experience and regulate life. You will hear information that is so practical, you will be able to go home and use it straight away.

Navigating the Adolescent Years 10 years +

The adolescent years are an incredible time for change. So much is going on for our young as they transition from children to adults. This session will outline the main changes that are physically happening in their brains and in their bodies. You will be amazed at what is going on, and it will make so much sense!

Understanding the changes, and how they affect our adolescents, will give you an increased ability to deal with the behaviour that results from them. The beauty of this session is that you can take the information and immediately apply it to your world. Reports of you have changed our households and 'I get it now' are very common feedbacks from those who attend this session. Come along and hear how it can help you too.



ENGAGE

Engage is a mother of two adolescents, with 18 years in the education field. She will explain what is going on in simple, easy-to-understand language.

Kathryn has been working in this area and making international audiences for over sixteen years, working with groups such as Pickle, Teachers, Parents, Social Workers, Nurturing and many more.
