Dear Team Bayview,

WINTER ILLS

Winter has arrived with a bang and with it the normals ills and chills! We currently have a bad head cold going through the school and a vomiting bug! Just a reminder that if your child is sick they should not attend school. This allows them to recover and keeps the other children safe by stopping the spread of germs. If we contact you to come and collect your child it will be because they are just not coping at school. We very much appreciate the parents who pick their children up quickly as our sickbay is a busy place and having children vomiting or distressed by severe coughing bouts can spread germs to others very quickly.

Please make sure if your child complains of a sore throat that you have it checked out by a doctor. Strep throat can lead to Rheumatic fever which can lead to heart disease. This is a serious condition and should not be treated lightly.

It is very important that your child has a school polar fleece that they can wear during the cold mornings. Please note by first break many children get hot and take their fleece off. We can only return these if your child's name is clearly written on a tag or sewn/embroidered into the jumper.

Students are welcome to wear a blue or black long sleeve top under their polo shirt if they really feel the cold. I also have no issue if your child wants to wear a beanie to school on cold mornings with a scarf, all I ask is that they do not have any offensive images or messages on them i.e. a hand doing the fingers, swear words, or a marijuana leaf, etc.

In January Kathryn spoke at our annual teachers' conference around building resilience in our students. Kathryn was inspirational, so much so, that the principals wanted to ensure that our community have an opportunity to hear Kathryn's messages. There are two different sessions depending on the age of your child/ren. Come to one or both!

The Early Years

5-9 years

We all want our children and young ones to be able to make good decisions, to over-ride impulses and to be able to function in a socially acceptable way. These, in our own ways, are how we become good contributing citizens to our community. So how do we build the ability to do this? How do we help our children learn to operate in a way that will assist them throughout their lives, whatever bumps and waves come at them?

This neuroscience session, delivered in easy to understand language, will help you see how you can play a crucial role in developing this in your children. The information will show you how you can build resilience, encourage emotional intelligence and individually support them to experience and negotiate life. You will hear information that is so practical, you will be able to go home and use it straight away.

Navigating the Adolescent Years

10 years +

The adolescent years are an incredible time for change. So much is going on for our youth as they transition from children to adults. This session will outline the main changes that are physically happening in their brains and in their bodies. You will be amazed at what is going on, and it will make so much sense!

Understanding the changes, and how they affect our adolescents, will give you an increased ability to deal with the behaviour that results from them. The beauty of this session is that you can take the information and immediately apply it to your world. Reports of 'you have changed our household' and 'I get it now' are very common feedbacks from those who attend this session. Come along and hear how it can help you too.



Kathryn is a mother of two adolescents, with a Masters in Educational Psychology. She will explain what is going on in simple, easy-to-understand language.
