Greetings to all Parents, Caregivers, and whanau,

Wow - only 15 more school days of this term left - and so much to do! This week is another busy week before we head off to the Wellington Zoo next week.

We are having a break from the Keeping Ourselves Safe (KOS) programme but Constable Rob and Hayley will be back next week on Wednesday and Thursday.

ZOO TRIP:

Our much anticipated overnight Zoo Trip is all planned for next Monday / Tuesday. PLEASE complete the attached permission slip and return to school **tomorrow** so that



we can confirm numbers attending and book for other activities / vans / relief teachers etc.

This permission notice is also being sent by the **SKOOL LOOP app** - so you are able to complete (and sign) it on line. If your child is <u>NOT</u> attending please complete the attached form.

There is a \$35.00 cost per student that must be paid prior to Friday (this has been in the newsletter for several weeks) - this is to help cover costs of food, petrol and other activities. Please contact the school if you have a problem with this.

Once we know the number of students attending we will book a relieving teacher for the two days if there are sufficient children not coming to the Zoo.

Rongowhakaata" (the Story of Light & Shadow); "Guardians" - which looks at how we can help protect our native species and "Unique New Zealand"

which looks at our wonderful wildlife.

Start our ZOO Adventure!

Leave Te Papa - PIZZA for tea.

Later: Supper and bed.

Tuesday am: Breakfast and pack up.

Continue with our Zoo experience.

11.00am ish: Leave Wellington

12.30 pm: Levin Aquatic Centre

Lunch / swim

2.00pm: Leave for Wanganui

3.00pm Children arrive home.

WE LEARN:

As part of our Professional Development last Friday the school is



going to be implementing the "We Learn" IT programme for all students in the school, which will see each individual student receive a "We Learn" e-mail address and each students work that is completed on the computers will be accessible by the teachers remotely. This programme will also enable us to keep a close look on what each individual student is viewing on line and set / lock specific websites for students to access when carrying out their work! This will take a little bit of time to set up but hopefully we will have it done prior to the end of term and ready for Term 3.



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LIFE EDUCATION PROGAMME:

Although the Life Education programme is officially finished - with Harold and Mark returning to town, students are still working on completing their booklets and may bring these home to complete or work through them with input from you as parents / caregivers.



If the content of these books raises any concerns please feel free to contact the school for advice (more so seniors programme).

The school does have available a "Social Worker in Schools" and we are also having "Paul" a drug, alcohol and mental well being Social Worker, coming to school to engage with senior students for a couple of sessions.

Reports will be sent out on the last Friday of the holidays and 3 Way Interviews will take place in the first or second week of term 3.
