BOARD OF TRUSTEES

How lucky are we that we had 11 people stand for our recent Board of Trustees elections. Each and every candidate was top quality and I would have been proud to have served alongside them on the Bayview School Board. I would like to publicly thank each of the candidates for volunteering for this position. We had five positions that needed filling and our Board for the next three years has a combination of experience, knowledge and specific skills required for governance. This board will be responsible for ushering in the upcoming changes to the education system as suggested by the recent Tomorrow's Schools review. The government is yet to decide exactly what changes they will make but some of the suggestions have been around disbanding the Ministry of Education and developing local Hubs that oversee a cluster of schools; disestablishing the Education Review Office and establishing 'inspectors' that would be regular visitors in schools supporting student achievement; the new Education Hubs overseeing human resourcing in schools, i.e. they would assist with employing new staff; the Education Hubs taking over all property works in schools. At the moment it is business as usual and will continue thus, until any new changes are brought into legislation.

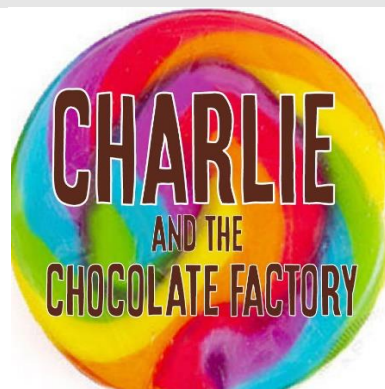
