- Or to get an update or add info to a previous report

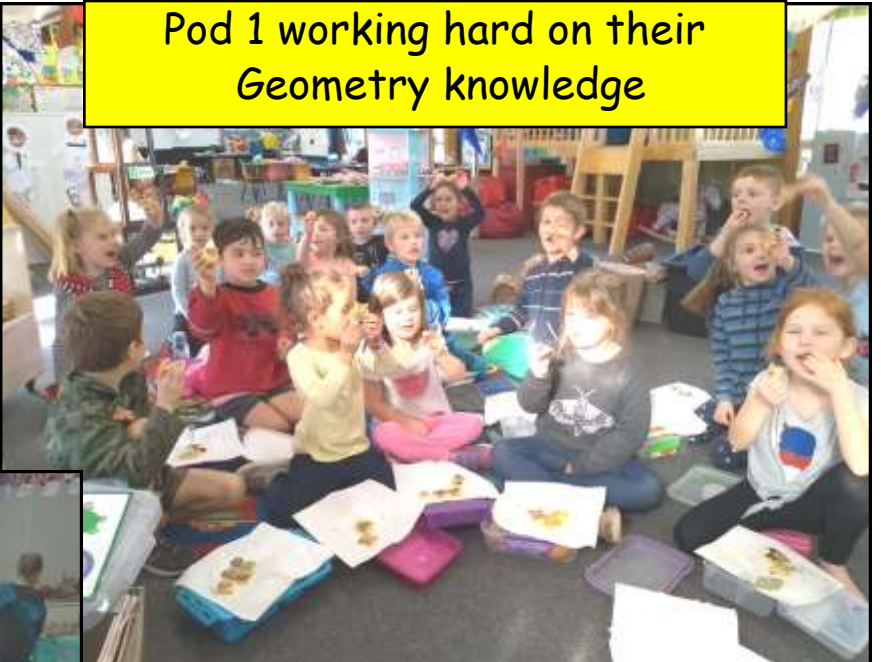

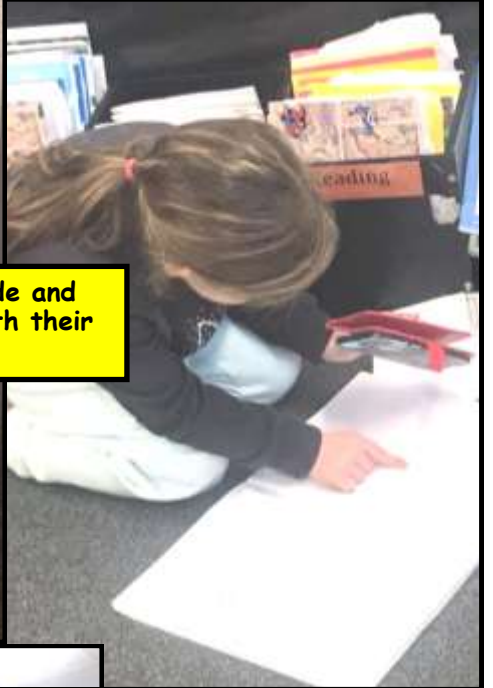
