After meeting with Bruce McRobbie and then discussing it as a Board of Trustees it has been decided that we will not be having calves at Livestock Day this year due to the risk of Mycoplasma Bovis. We are aware that the potential risk is small but the effect would be devastating to our community if an animal contracted this disease from this event. The school would also be potentially liable as we would be going against expert advice that we had sought. Most other rural schools in the Morrinsville area, group day and the Waikato A and P show have also decided to exclude calves this year.

The upcoming Livestock Day will have stringent quarantine procedures for lambs and kids which we will communicate with entrants closer to the time.

We realise that some children and families will be disappointed with this decision but we hope they will enjoy the experience of raising a kid or lamb instead.

Matariki Learning


