CROSS COUNTRY:

Our annual Whanganui East Rural Schools Cluster Cross-Country at Whangaehu School will be held THIS Friday 6th September.

If your child is not taking part in the cross-country then they will need to stay at home as we will require all staff at the cross-country event.

Children will be picked up from home approximately 1 hour later than normal as we will not be coming up to school first. Arrangements will be made for Aberfeldy students to meet us in town.

We will all meet at the library at 9.00am for a walk around Queens Park and then some quiet time in the library from 9.30am until we are ready to leave for Whangaehu at 10.00am. You are welcome to come along and join us at Whangaehu School for the day.

Children should be arriving home by 3.00pm (ish).

- Date 6th September, postponement date13th September
- Start time 11.00 am
- Races will be by age. 5-year-old boys, then girls through to 12+ year old boys then girls. This means there will be 16 races in total.
- There will be 4 different courses.

5 and 6-year olds – approx. 500m. 7 and 8-year olds – approx. 1000m. 9 and 10-year olds – approx. 1400m 11 and 12- year olds – approx. 2000m.

- The courses will be marshalled, and the children will follow a 'hare'.
- Schools will be based on the top field and courts with the races taking place on the bottom field and surrounding farmer's fields. Only competitors will be allowed on the bottom field. The races can be viewed from the top field and playground. The finish will be on the top field for all to see.
- There will be a race briefing at 10.50 am.
- Food will be available to buy on the day. There will be a sausage sizzle (\$2) and home baking. Hopefully the coffee cart will be here too.
- Parking is limited. All minivans/buses must park at the Hall carpark following drop off. We will endeavour to provide parking for cars in a paddock next to the school but suggest that drop off and parking at the Hall may be a better option.
- Children MUST BRING suitable shoes fro running in (they are running over farm land - there will be prickles etc), suitable clothing for running then a warm jersey or top to put on, a rain jacket, morning tea, lunch and plenty to drink.
