Principal's Comments:

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Thank you for supporting your children this

term with their learning and reinforcing their values. It has been fascinating watching the students interact with others in our intensives and celebrations. Your child has probably mentioned our trial of eating lunch at the end of lunchtime (1.15pm). This has been very successful and I have received positive feedback from parents, staff and students.



On Friday 18 October at 7pm we will be hosting our annual Dads' Night, with the main purpose being to ensure that the Dads are organised for the Battle of the Schools, which is on Saturday 7 March 2020 along with our annual fair.

In Term 4 we will again promote walking, biking or scootering to school. In a survey carried out by Auckland Transport 40% of our students came to school in a car over a two week period in early June...and the weather was nice. Please encourage your children to come to school by walking, biking or scootering and ensure their bikes and scooters are safe.

We have been very fortunate that we have not had any reported cases of measles at our school. Joyce has a list of children who were partially immunised (33), not immunised (20) or unknown immunisation (25), which is when the enrolment form has been ticked but we have not seen any proof of immunisation at the time of starting school). If you have an update you could provide to the office regarding immunisation since your child enrolled, or you are not sure, please contact Joyce in the office. Just to reiterate, we have had NO reports of any children so far who have presented with measles. However, we do need to have an updated list, because if there was a child at our school with measles, we would need to keep unvaccinated or partially vaccinated children at home until we get the all clear from the Ministry of Health.

Finally, I wish you all a safe break and I hope all the children come back refreshed for another exciting term of learning.
