Movin' March begins next week!!

We're a Movin'March school and we can't wait to make the most of this beautiful weather and encourage your child/ren to Walk or Wheel to and from school. Explore the website for tips and check out the parents page on how to build active travel into your daily routine. This year we'll be encouraging whānau to take part in the <u>Parent</u> <u>Facebook</u> competition (daily prizes plus one scooter to give away every week!) and the <u>Share your Story</u> competition which has weekly prizes (plus a family pass on Bluebridge Ferries!)

Why Movin'March?

Not only does walking or wheeling to school reduce congestion and chaos at the school gate, we also get to slow down and get some quality time with our tamariki. Walking or wheeling to school solo or with friends can be a real <u>confidence boost</u> and families get to do their bit for the environment!

How to make it work for your whanau

- Instead of driving right up to the school gate, why not <u>Park and Stride</u>? Walk the last 500m or so to school and get your passport stamped at the classroom!
- Think about how you might get to and from school over March (and the rest of Term 1!) Check out Micro scooter's <u>safety tips</u> or <u>NZTA's Hike it Bike it</u> safety suggestions.
- <u>Walking School Buses</u> build community and teach children important road safety skills ready for walking independently as they get older. Perhaps you would like to set one up for Papakowhai School.

Always wear your helmet. If you have to cross a road, stop and get off your bike/scooter and walk across the road. If you use the crossing near Countdown always wait until the green light is on for pedestrians and walk your wheels across the road.

Skateboards can be brought to school on a Tuesday and/or a Thursday. Helmets must be worn when riding your skateboard.




ASSEMBLY NEXT WEEK
