BOARD OF TRUSTEES CASUAL VACANCY FOR AN ELECTED TRUSTEE

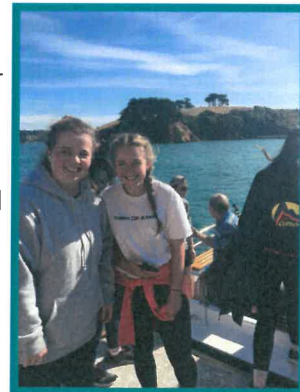

BIOLOGY FIELD TRIP

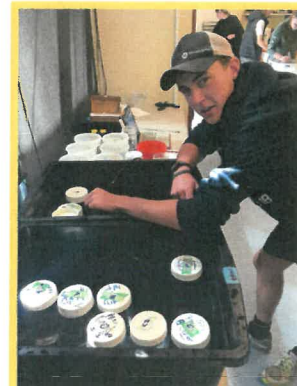
