#### Tēnā koutou LATEST UPDATES FOR COVID-19 Travel Restrictions

The existing travel restrictions for travellers from China and Iran have been extended for a further 7 days. The Prime Minister also announced yesterday that measures are now in place for travellers arriving from Northern Italy and from South Korea. They will be asked to self-isolate for 14 days (calculated from the date they left South Korea or Northern Italy). They are still able to travel to New Zealand; there is no restriction of access to New Zealand for people arriving from these two countries.

## Handwashing to prevent spread

All schools are still in the "Keep it Out" phase of a pandemic plan. The preventative measures the Ministry of Health is encouraging schools to practice are those of good hygiene, which include:

- Washing hands with soap and water (for at least 20 seconds) before and after eating as well as after attending the toilet
- Covering coughs and sneezes with clean tissues or with an elbow
- Putting used tissues in the bin
- Encouraging staff and students to stay home if they are unwell.

## Communication

If the status on pandemic planning changes, it is essential that we can communicate with you. This is how we need you to be connected:

<u>Weekly newsletter</u> – every Wednesday we send out a school newsletter by email and through our Skool Loop app (full details of this below). The newsletter is also

posted to our website <u>www.papakowhai.school.nz</u> If you don't already receive the newsletter this way, please provide an email address to the office to be included in the newsletter group. This group is also used to send out urgent notices and reminders.

<u>Skool Loop App</u> – this is free to download from the App Store (for Apple devices) or from Google play (for Android). Simply search for 'Skool Loop' and choose our school once installed. We use the App to send out notices and our latest newsletter. The app can also be used to return permission slips and view the school events calendar.

<u>SeeSaw</u> - We use Seesaw to share your child's work with you. You will receive a handout, personalised to your child, to enable you to access their work.

You can download the Seesaw Family App for iOS, Android, or use the web to view your student's learning.

When your child adds new work, you will receive a notification to see, hear and respond to your child's post. You only have access to your own child's work and all of the content is stored securely.
