GOOD NEWS STORIES

We all need some good news stories at the moment so here are a few from this week at school.

Te Wa Tuku Reo Māori

Hundreds of children at Papakowhai School participated in Te Wa Tuku Reo Māori (Māori language moment) at 12pm on Monday 14 September to celebrate te reo Māori. In 1972, 30,000 signatures were delivered to Parliament calling for te reo Māori to be taught in schools. It was a defining moment in the journey to revitalise our language. The aim is to grow one million speakers by 2040. Children participated in waiata, games and activities that use te reo Māori.

Our Library

Despite roll growth pressure we are keeping our library open for Term 4. We have created a small classroom in Rata block by converting two offices into a sunny little classroom for 10. We are thrilled that our children will have a great space to work in and the library will remain open for all our children in Term 4.

PAT and STAR Tests

Children in Years 3 -8 have recently completed these tests. Despite the challenges of this year, the results show that in almost all year groups progress made has exceeded expected levels of progress.

Maths results show that in Years 3 -7, 50% of Papakowhai Students scored at the same level or higher than the top 25% of students nationally. Year 8 students also scored well above average. Less than 10% of Papakowhai Students scored at the same level or lower than the bottom 25% of students nationally.

Reading results show that in Years 3,4,5 and 7, 50% of Papakowhai Students at the same level or higher than the top 25% of students nationally. Year 6 and 8 students also scored well above average. Less than 10% of Papakowhai Students scored at the same level or lower than the bottom 25% of students nationally.

We are really proud of the children's progress. Reports on your child's progress will be shared with you in Week 1 of Term 4. There will also be an opportunity to make an appointment to talk with your child's teacher in Week 2 Term 4.
