First enter your name, your student's name, and your email address.

If you need to book for more than one student, change the "Book for 1 students" setting, and enter the other student's name.



On the next page, pick your child/children's teacher you want to meet and then press "Go"



Then you'll see a timetable showing when your chosen teacher is available. Simply click on the times that suit you and then press "Go"

When you have finished, your interview timetable will be emailed to you. And you can return to the site and enter the event code **qvthc** again to change or cancel your interviews.

If you don't have internet access, please call the school office. If the office is unattended please leave a message stating your name, your child's name, your child's new room number and the desired time that you would like to meet with the teacher.


