

# PAPAKOWHAI SCHOOL NEWSLETTER Week 7 ● Term 1 ● 17 March 2021

## Kia ora koutou

We had a wonderful junior school assembly this morning. All classes from Rata and Matai shared their work. We also introduced the 17 children who have started school since the start of the year.

I am so proud of all the students who shared work today. It is not easy to stand up and speak in front of so many people.

At the assembly this morning I told a story about classrooms and reading that exemplifies our Papakowhai School values. I would like to retell it to you...

The BOT shared with you last week that the four new classrooms being added to Papakowhai School have been delayed until the start of Term 3. This is Ministry of Education process issues not the BOT's.

All term I have been concerned that the delay would mean we would have to close our library. However, because they really value reading at our school, the staff have agreed to go without a staffroom for Term 2 so that library can remain open. Rachel Berney and Sara Watchorn open Rata 5 next week in a small classroom space we have created in the far corner of Rata. This will be perfect for the rest of term as there are only a handful of students in this class. This class will be full by June and so from the start of Term 2 this class will be in what is currently our staffroom.

I am very proud of our staff for making this sacrifice and it shows that they really place the children's best interests at the heart of what they do. The staff will take their morning tea and lunch breaks in the hall but the hall will still be able to be used for before and after school care, for school activities during the day and for hall hire in the evenings.

I challenged our youngest students today that when they don't feel like reading at home, or making an effort to select a new book to bring home, to think of the staff giving up the staffroom for the benefit of reading at our school and do the right thing.

I know that parents and caregivers are busy and there are many competing pressures so it can be hard to make the time to read with your children at home. My challenge to you today is on days when it can be hard to fit in reading at home to think of our staff making a sacrifice for readers and make it a priority. It really makes a difference!


## **GIFTED AND TALENTED EDUCATION**
