Assessment and Reporting

Over the next few weeks, students will complete their Term 1 assessments with their teachers. Students in Years 3-8 have finished standardised tests in Reading and Maths. Students in Years 1-3 are doing oral Reading Assessments (called Running Records) where they read a story or part of a story and the teacher analyses the strategies they are using to decode text and check their comprehension. Students in Years 1-8 are also doing oral Maths assessments to check their Number strategies. All students have also completed writing samples, which teachers analyse for strengths and next steps.

Teachers use these assessments and in-class observations to make teacher judgements against the levels of the New Zealand Curriculum. We do this for all children who have had at least two terms at school. For children in their first six months at school we only report on Key Competencies and personal and social development.

Teachers will complete reports on all students by the end of term and these will be shared with you in

Week 1 of Term 2. There will be an opportunity in Week 2 of Term 2 to make an appointment with your child's teacher to discuss their progress.

TAX CREDIT FOR DONATIONS AND CONTRIBUTIONS

School donations and contributions qualify for a 33.33 cents per \$1 paid tax credit available through IRD. If you have paid by 31 March 2021 it can be applied as a tax credit for this tax year. Signed receipts are provided to you.

It is now easier to claim for your tax credit - the following is taken directly from the IRD website; "The easiest way to claim your donation tax credit is online in myIR - and you'll receive your refund sooner. Using myIR means we can work out your tax credit

without you having to file a claim when the tax year ends on 31 March.

You can submit your receipts any time throughout the tax year or submit them all together at the end of the tax year. You need to wait till after end of the tax year to receive your tax credit."

Statements of account are being issued this week to advise of the balances in your student accounts.
