CLASSROOM CHANGES FOR TERM 4

Please see the BOT newsletter today with more information about our current building projects.

At the start of Term 4:

Rata 5 (currently in the staffroom) will move to the hall. The classroom will be screened off and permanently set up in one third of the hall. There will be no other hall users during school learning time. After/Before School Care and evening hall users will continue to operate in the hall but in a reduced space. The staff will continue to use the hall at break times as our staffroom extension project begins in Term 4.

Rata 6 (currently operating in the Rata back room) will move to the middle mat space in Rata. Photocopiers, toys and equipment currently in this space will be moved. Rata 6 will still have access to part of the back room as a quiet space.

By November 8th, we are expecting:

All Matai classes will move to the new block on the field. I know it is hard to imagine the classes being ready when you see the site, but the classrooms are all finished in the factory, it is just the groundwork that needs finishing.

Rata 5 will move to Matai 3 at the top of the Rimu stairs

Rata 6 will move to Matai 2 (prefab on the side of the netball court)

Thank you for your patience. It has been the most challenging of seasons but I am really proud of the staff and the students for their flexibility and resilience. The end is in sight and I am really looking forward to having this work behind us as we start 2022.

ENROLMENTS FOR 2022

Out of Zone Places

If you currently live <u>out of zone</u>, have children already attending Papakōwhai School, you have a new entrant child who turns 5 in 2022 and you have not already completed an enrolment form for 2022 please contact me by Friday 1 October at the latest.

The number of out of zone places for 2022 for Year 1 siblings of current pupils will be determined by the Board of Trustees.

The process is as follows:

- •Pre-enrolment of out of zone Year 1 children who have a sibling currently attending Papakōwhai School will need to be received by October 1st, 2021.
- •The BOT will determine from the pre-enrolments how many places are likely to be available in 2022 for out of zone Year 1 siblings of current students at the October 26th meeting.
- •The BOT will advise the number of out of zone places and a ballot, if required, will take place before the end of October.

There will be no places for children who do not have a current sibling at school.

In Zone Places

To assist with planning for 2022 we need to check we have an accurate list of enrolments for next year.

If you fall into one of following categories, please contact the Office by Friday October 1st:

- i) You live <u>in zone</u> and have a new entrant child who turns 5 in 2022 and you have not already given pre-enrolment details to the Office.
- ii) You live <u>in zone</u> and currently have a child attending a different school that you intend to enrol at Papakōwhai in 2022.

If you have a friend or family member that does not have a child currently attending Papakōwhai School and you think that they may fall into one of the above categories, please get them to contact the Office also.

Leavers

If you have a Year 1 - 7 child currently attending Papakōwhai School and you are planning to enrol them at a different school in 2022 please notify the principal by October 1st.

If you are unclear about the boundaries of the school zone, please refer to our website. Please note all streets that are part of the "grandparenting clause" are counted as in–zone enrolments. If you have any questions or concerns about your child's eligibility to enrol at Papakōwhai School in 2022 please contact me.
