STEP RIGHT UP MATAI AND RATA 5!

The block is finished!

From Friday Rātā 5 will be working in the new block. Mataī classes may start on Friday or Monday. Your teacher will advise you.

In recognition of this change, parents and caregivers of Rātā and Mataī will be allowed onsite to take their children to class. We ask that adults wear a face covering and you must sign in using the tracer app. This is on display at the gate and outside the classrooms. Parents and caregivers will not be able to come inside the classroom but you are welcome on the new deck.

The construction site is still a work in progress. You can access the new block from Yarrow Place (by the Kindergarten) and you can come down the path by the pool and access the block from the field. The pathway on the western side of the hall remains closed as the asphalt could not be laid this week due to the rain. This will be finished before Christmas.

The toilets for the new block are still to be added so children will need to come up the path by the hall to access the toilets between Totara and Kauri blocks. We are working hard to have new toilets in place for the start of 2022.

Thank you for your patience during what has been a very long and difficult building project.

CLASS PLACEMENT LETTERS

These will be sent home on Friday, 13th December. The class placement letter also contains information about start of year arrangements, dates and times.

We have read through hundreds of parent requests and taken these into account when we have placed your children. If you did not get your request it does not mean you were not listened to or your request not valued.

In determining class placement we look at age, gender balance, balancing the learning and behavioural needs in the class, parent requests and teacher recommendations. It is a careful and considered process.

If you do not receive your child's class placement letter, please contact me. We generally provide one copy of the class placement letter per family and ask that you share this. If this is not possible and you need a duplicate copy please let me know and I will email it to you.
