Papakōwhai School remains open for instruction. This information is being provided should the school need to close or if you or your family need to self isolate.

All home learning work will be communicated using SeeSaw. Your child received their home learning code today. Please check their school bags. It is important that you keep this in a safe place. If you don't receive this or you are not yet set up on SeeSaw, please contact your child's teacher directly.

You can download the Seesaw Family App for iOS, Android, or use the web to view your student's learning. If you are having trouble connecting to SeeSaw please contact Karen Siwalette, karen@papakowhai.school.nz

Every Monday we will send out to the entire school an online learning plan for the week. If your child is well and at school you can disregard the notification.

If your child is sick they should stay home, rest and not do home learning. Please contact the office to say they are sick.

If your child and family need to self isolate because they are a close contact or have had Covid 19 please contact the office to say your child is self isolating and will be learning at home.

If your child is at home because school is closed we will all be doing online learning so there is no need to contact the office.

NEWSLETTER

Please keep up to date by reading the weekly newsletter – every Wednesday we send out a school newsletter by email and through our Skool Loop app (details of this below). The newsletter is also posted to our website www.papakowhai.school.nz If you don't already receive the newsletter this way, please provide an email address to the office to be included in the newsletter group. This group is also used to send out urgent notices and reminders.

Skool Loop App – this is free to download from the App Store (for Apple devices) or from Google play (for Android). Simply search for 'Skool Loop' and choose our school once installed. We use the App to send out notices and our latest newsletter.

HOME LEARNING EXPECTATIONS

While the majority of children are at school we will send out a weekly plan for children to follow. If the majority of children are learning at home we will send out daily plans. We will provide two hours of specific literacy and Maths and inquiry work for children to do each day. There will be options to do other art, PE, or inquiry work if families want it. No work is compulsory. We won't require things to be done at a set time. If children cannot participate in a zoom meeting that's not a problem. Do what you can, when you can.

DIGITAL DEVICES FOR LEARNING AT HOME

To prepare for online learning at any time, we need all Year 6 - 8 students who have a BYOD device to take their device and charger home every night.

For other learners we are able to supply devices while you are learning at home. Only fill in this form if:

- 1. You are required to self isolate at home because you are a close contact
- 2. You are required to continue self isolating after having Covid-19
- 3. The MOE requires the school to close.

MANAGING WORKLOAD
