BUILDING REPAIRS

On Friday 9th September the board and I met with the Right Honourable Paula Bennett, local MP for Bayview. We outlined some of our frustrations around getting our roof replaced and our other building completed projects (drainage, electrical circuit board upgrades and toilet upgrades). Paula listened to our concerns over delays and lack of funding and has gone in to bat for us! We also spoke about our roll growth and our desire to have some classrooms built accommodate this growth. This is something we will work alongside the Ministry of Education on. The BOT recognises that habitats 4 and 5 are nearing the end of their life and our desire would be to demolish these classes and build new ones.

BYOD, INNOVATIVE LEARNING, E-LEARNING

This year we have 2 e-learning 1 innovative learning classes, environment and 4 BYOD classes. Next year we will be looking to expand this by providing more opportunities for students to be in ILE's and BYOD classes across all levels of the school.
