Dear Bayview Families,

Wow! It is hard to believe that we have reached the end of the school year! What a crazy, fabulous year we have had!

I am incredibly proud to work alongside the most dedicated, innovative and world class staff. Our teachers get to school at 7am and some don't leave until 6pm! Who said teaching was a 9-3 job?! Every student is treated as an individual and our teachers work tirelessly to provide them with the best educational opportunities.

We are very proud to have received a 4-5 year ERO review this year. This is the result of a lot of hard work by our staff and our students. Bayview is held in very high regard by other educators and we have many visitors that come to our school to see best practice and to assist with their own professional development.

We have an incredibly supportive and caring community with parents volunteering their time so willingly to help the school achieve its goals. We truly could not give the children the opportunities they have without your continuing support. We hope lots of you will be able to volunteer your time in 2017 to help with patrols, sports teams, fundraising, walking school bus and the many other activities we have at school.

#### **END OF YEAR EVENTS**

Our teachers have been busy assessing students this term and then writing their summative school report for 2016. Reports will be sent home on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> December. With the report will be the final newsletter for the year, a stationery list and other important information.

We hope many of you will be able to attend some or all of the prizegiving assemblies coming up. If your child is receiving an award we will contact you so you can make sure you can be there. We don't tell the children if they are receiving an award. We ask that all students are in the correct school uniform for prizegiving assemblies please. (Please note the light blue polo shirt without the dark blue and yellow collar is NOT the correct school uniform and should not be worn to school any longer).

#### SUMMER BREAK BUILDING WORK

Over the summer break there will be extensive building work being completed at Bayview School. The roof of our main area of the school is being replaced. This will be a hive of activity and will pose a significant hazard to people using the school grounds. We advise all parents that they should not allow children to come up to school to play over the summer break.

We know this may be an inconvenience but the safety of your children and yourselves comes first. There will be fencing around the areas posing the greatest risk, but we still suggest you keep your children away from the school grounds to be sure.

We are also due to re-roof Habitats 12-16 and this will be done in April.

Our Board of Trustees will be sending home a separate note regarding this building work to ensure every parent is aware of what is happening and the dangers involved.

We also need your help in dealing with the young people currently causing concern in the school and the greater Bayview area. We have had them try to burn down the fale, they have broken into the chicken coop and terrified the chickens, burnt play equipment, smashed up a target board, climbed on the hall roof, stolen padlocks and other gear, and tried to break the gate on the main entrance. If you see any kids causing damage please contact the police on 111 and tell them what is happening. Any photos or videos of the kids concerned will be very helpful.

I have informed the Glenfield police of what has happened so far and asked them to keep us on their radar over the summer break but unfortunately they aren't able to do much without solid evidence of who is committing the crimes.
