## Kia ora Whanau, Community Members and Friends of Eltham School

Last Thursday Barb Frey was appointed as our Board Chair. We feel very privileged to have someone with Barb's level of expertise on our school board and we look forward to progressing with her valued input. The following blurb is an introduction from Barb...

I was originally Canadian and returned to NZ a year ago after 20 years working as a vet in Australia. I currently work as a vet at Riverlands in Eltham and also other freezer works in Taranaki. I live in Ohangai. I was co-opted onto the Board late last year by the previous Chair due to my board experience; having served on several company boards and being chair of a primary school board in Perth for six years. I was also the school scientist, a voluntary role with year 5 and 6 students aimed at getting kids interested in science. I'm not sure how many kids got interested in science, but it was certainly a lot of fun!

I believe that volunteering in the community is a great way to get to know people, especially children, so serving on a local school board is a natural choice. My only daughter died as a toddler. I have been a foster parent to quite a number of children, and also have several godchildren, one of whom lived with me from the age of 14 (now 22 and studying at uni). I am grateful for the encouragement I got at school as a child. This made a big difference to my education and the opportunities that came as a result. I'm clear from my own experience that the support of teachers and a good education are among the key things that give kids a great start in life. I'm looking forward to serving as Board Chair, and hope that parents in the school community find it interesting to learn about the function of the Board of Trustees and how it is meant to support the school.


