Our International Food Festival is on this **Friday evening 17 March** from 4.30 pm – 7 pm.

We have a great evening planned again this year with a huge variety of food on offer, prepared and served by our amazing Sunnybrae parents.

NOTE: This year we will be running a cash-less system. You will be able to buy \$1 tickets from various locations at the food festival and you can use those tickets to buy food, drinks and activities. You will not be able to pay for any food and drink or activities/rides with cash, with the exception of the coffee cart. EFTPOS will be available in the office.

Tickets will be available to purchase from the school office from Monday onwards. It is recommended that you buy some tickets during the week if you can, to avoid queues on the night. There will be no refunds on un-used tickets.

There is also a great opportunity to enjoy our Senior students KapaHaka item and be entertained by our Junior syndicate children. The entertainment kicks off at 4.30pm so please come and support your friends and family, and if your child is involved in performing they should be there at the start as they will perform first.
