Introducing our new in school Health Support Team, who will be at MBS Mon – Wed helping us have a healthy school.

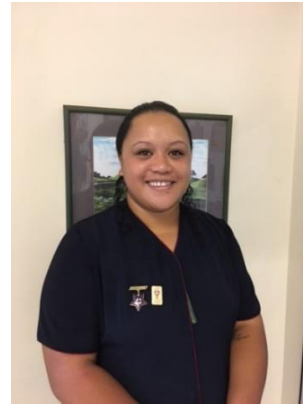
Malo lei lei
