Daffodil bulb Planting

This week the South Taranaki Council donated 800 daffodil bulbs to Eltham School as part of their daffodil planting programme which was started in 2008. This year involves 2,000 bulbs being planted by the STDC Parks Staff and Community Groups.

The plan is to plant bulbs in areas that can be seen from the State Highways with bulbs going in the Manaia Skate park, Sandfords Event Centre at Opunake and Eltham Primary School grounds. We are very grateful for this generous donation. These bulbs, and some that were purchased by our school, were planted along High Street by our staff, children and



parent helpers. Big thanks especially to our wonderful year 7 and 8 students who dug a trench to plant the bulbs. We hope to plant more daffodil bulbs along Conway Road next term.
