Keeping Ourselves Safe

Over the next 4 weeks all of our students will participate in the *Keeping Ourselves Safe* programme. This programme has been developed by the NZ Police and the Ministry of Education. It will be taught by your child's teacher. Our Police Education Officer, Steve Harwood, will take some of the lessons. This programme enables children and young people to learn and apply a range of safety skills that they can use when interacting with others. Students recognise the differences between healthy and unhealthy relationships, and those who have been or are being abused are encouraged to seek help.

A parents' meeting was held last term; it was good to see parents taking advantage of this offer. If you have questions about the programme please talk with your child's teacher.

Road Safety Week

Next week (8 - 14 May) has been designated Road Safety Week and our school has registered for this. The theme is *Speed - Slow Down on Roads*. Anita Kumar is an exercise physiologist currently working for Te Puna Hauora Medical Centre under a Whānau Ora contract.
